Action Log Update

Trees on the Village Green

The Parish clerk provided councillors quotes for the removal of dead wood on the trees surrounding St James Church and the Village Green.

Cllr. John Taylor advised the trees on the main road running through the village may be the responsibility of ERYC Highways. Cllr. John Taylor proposed contacting ERYC requesting which trees they will take ownership for seconded Cllr. Simon Harris and agreed.

Lamp Post Poppies

The Parish Clerk advised the lamp post poppies were no longer available.

Village Green Lighting

The Parish Clerk provided councillors with a quote for the tree lights on the village green. The parish clerk advised she had tried to obtain further quotes but due to the work including groundworks no other company was forthcoming with costs. Cllr. Pauline Sykes proposed installing the lights to light up 3 large trees on the green seconded Cllr. Paul Barnett and agreed.

The Parish Clerk asked for a show of hands in favour of the lighting. All councillors voted in favour of the lights on the green.

Code of Conduct Update
